This is a full-time job in the Information Technology division of the Administration Department at The Butchart Gardens. Staff in this position implement, support and sustain The Gardens' core technical infrastructure. Areas of responsibility include core networking, security, storage, backups, directory services, CCTV, application support, along with other related systems. The ideal candidate will have a dedication to continuous learning, be adaptable to the rapidly changing IT landscape, and look forward to the challenge of building and maintaining complex critical systems.

IT Systems Specialists are responsible for all of the following areas:

Application Support: customize, maintain, and support software. This may include writing application interfaces, customizing Vendor software and writing custom reports.

Database Support: install, monitor, maintain, and performance tune databases while ensuring high levels of data availability.

Desktop Support: manage PC's laptops, mobile devices, operating systems, install applications, and peripheral devices. This includes developing and testing application deployment packages for both virtual and physical systems.

Network Support: to support the stable operation of the computer network security services. This includes servers, network hardware, and monitoring systems.

System Security: Maintain and facilitate best practices to protect The Butchart Gardens network via firewalls, backups, training, real-time threat detection and mitigation, and disaster recovery planning.

Internet Support: develop, install and maintain hardware and software web technologies, including desktop and mobile.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Install, configure, and monitor operational status of hardware and/or software
- Recommend, schedule, and perform system upgrades and patches
- Test and verification of firmware and software across many departments
- Produce and maintain various types of documentation such as: technical specifications, operational
 procedures, software/hardware configuration, reports, and training materials and provide training as
 needed
- Troubleshoot incidents, and problems, collaborate with external vendors and other partnerships where needed to resolve
- Participate in new initiatives and new projects, both independently and in a team environment
- Research emerging technologies, evaluate and prepare recommendations to support continued development of systems and improve service delivery
- Suggest initiatives to enrich Information Technology services.
- Perform other related duties as required
- Weekend and evening work will be required in certain seasons
