The Night Custodial Department is responsible for maintaining the cleanliness and hygiene standards of the general buildings including vacuuming, mopping, sweeping and scrubbing.

The successful candidate will be required to:

- sweeping, mopping, scrubbing and vacuuming of kitchens, restaurants, coffee shop, cafeteria, employee break rooms, office areas, stairs, elevators and other common use areas
- clean non-slip concrete, concrete, linoleum, ceramic tile, hardwood, vinyl and slate floors
- report issues or safety hazards such as damaged or broken equipment to their supervisors
- use industrial vacuum cleaner to remove scraps, dirt, debris and other refuse
- work alone and at night with minimal supervision

The successful candidate must possess the following qualifications and demonstrated attributes:

- applicants must be able to work effectively with minimal supervision and follow instructions related to business maintenance.
- ability to take initiative and prioritize tasks effectively
- physical ability to perform repetitive tasks such as bending, lifting, reaching and scrubbing
- 1 year custodial or otherwise relevant experience is preferred.
